## FIREWOOD COLLECTION FROM ROADSIDE

Tatiara District Council has no objections to resident's collecting firewood for personal use from district roads, providing the following conditions are complied with:

- ✓ Only fallen timber is to be cut up and removed. **Standing material and hollow logs are not to be removed.**
- ✓ Avoid damage to any other native vegetation as well as to property belonging to the adjoining landowner, e.g. fences.
- ✓ Any remaining branches and foliage are to be left in a neat and tidy condition.
- ✓ Vehicles are to be parked off the roadway so they do not create a hazard to other road users.
- ✓ To avoid persons having to cross the carriageway, vehicles and trailers are to be parked on the same side of the road as the timber being picked up.
- ✓ Timber must be stacked safely and securely on vehicles and/or trailers so that nothing falls off on the journey home.
- ✓ Adequate fire prevention precautions are to be taken during dry conditions.
- ✓ Anyone wishing to collect timber from commercial use from roadsides must apply for approval in writing.
- ✓ This approval does not apply to Commons, Stone or Water Reserves, Parklands or Conservation Parks.
